June 26-June 30: Intensive Beginner French

First time learning French or very little French? Get an introduction to the French language and Francophone world this summer!

This course, built around workshops, will introduce the campers to the basics of the French language, with emphasis on speaking, listening and interaction and the discovery of the French cultures through activities based on games, music, videos, cooking and other hand-on cultural experiences.

July 10-14: French 1/2 – Conversation in French and French culture

This is an ideal camp for students who want to gain confidence in speaking and listening in French through interaction in a creative and relaxed setting.

Challenge yourself, improve your French with this course that develops communication skills while providing grammar reviews and insightful cultural discoveries for teenagers. Activities includes Songs, videos, acting, cooking... Students must have completed 1 or 2 years of French.

July 17-21: French 2/3 – Conversation in French and French culture

This is an ideal camp for students who want to gain confidence in speaking and listening in French through interaction in a creative and relaxed setting.

Challenge yourself, improve your French with this course that develops communication skills while providing grammar reviews and insightful cultural discoveries for teenagers. Activities includes Songs, videos, acting, cooking... Students must have completed 2 or 3 years of French.

July 24-28: French 3/4 - Listening and reading in French - Pre-AP

This is an ideal camp for students who want improve their comprehension, listening and speaking and practice interaction and argumentation in French in a creative and relaxed setting.

Discovery of Francophone contemporary cultures and societies through documents from the Francophone worlds. Participants must take a placement test prior to registration. Students must have completed 4 or more years of French.

A minimum of 3 students enrolled is required to run the camp.
